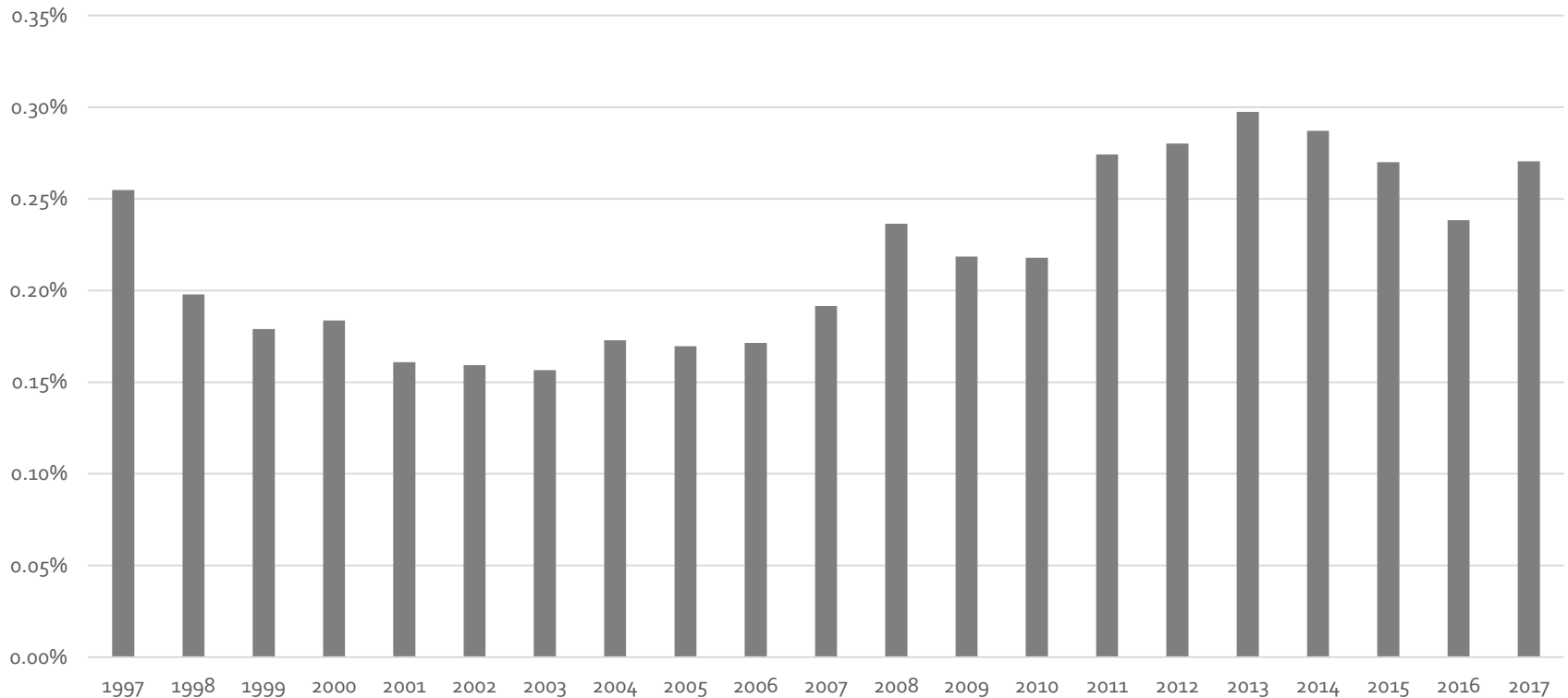

# Indonesian Trade Weight Has Declined over the Last Four Years

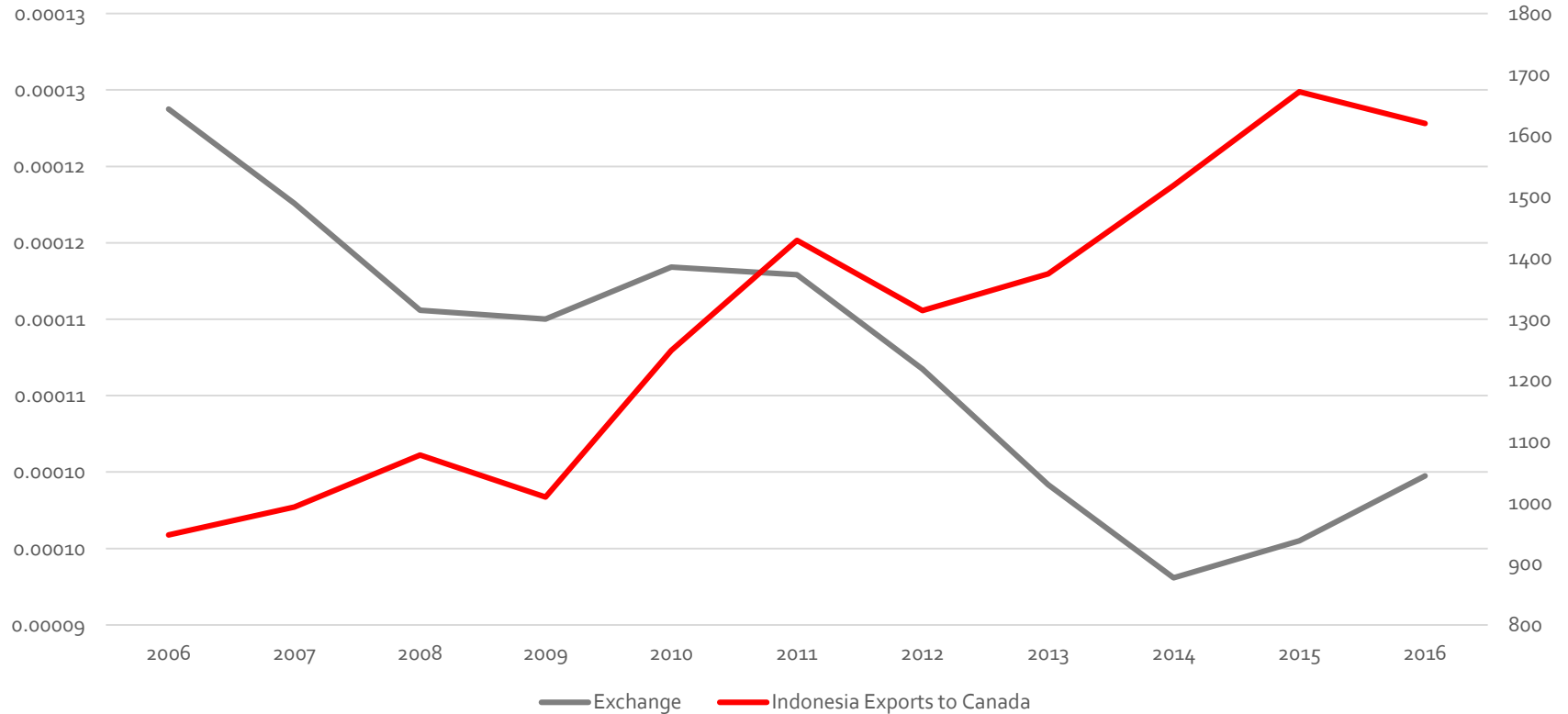
trade with Indonesia as a share of total trade

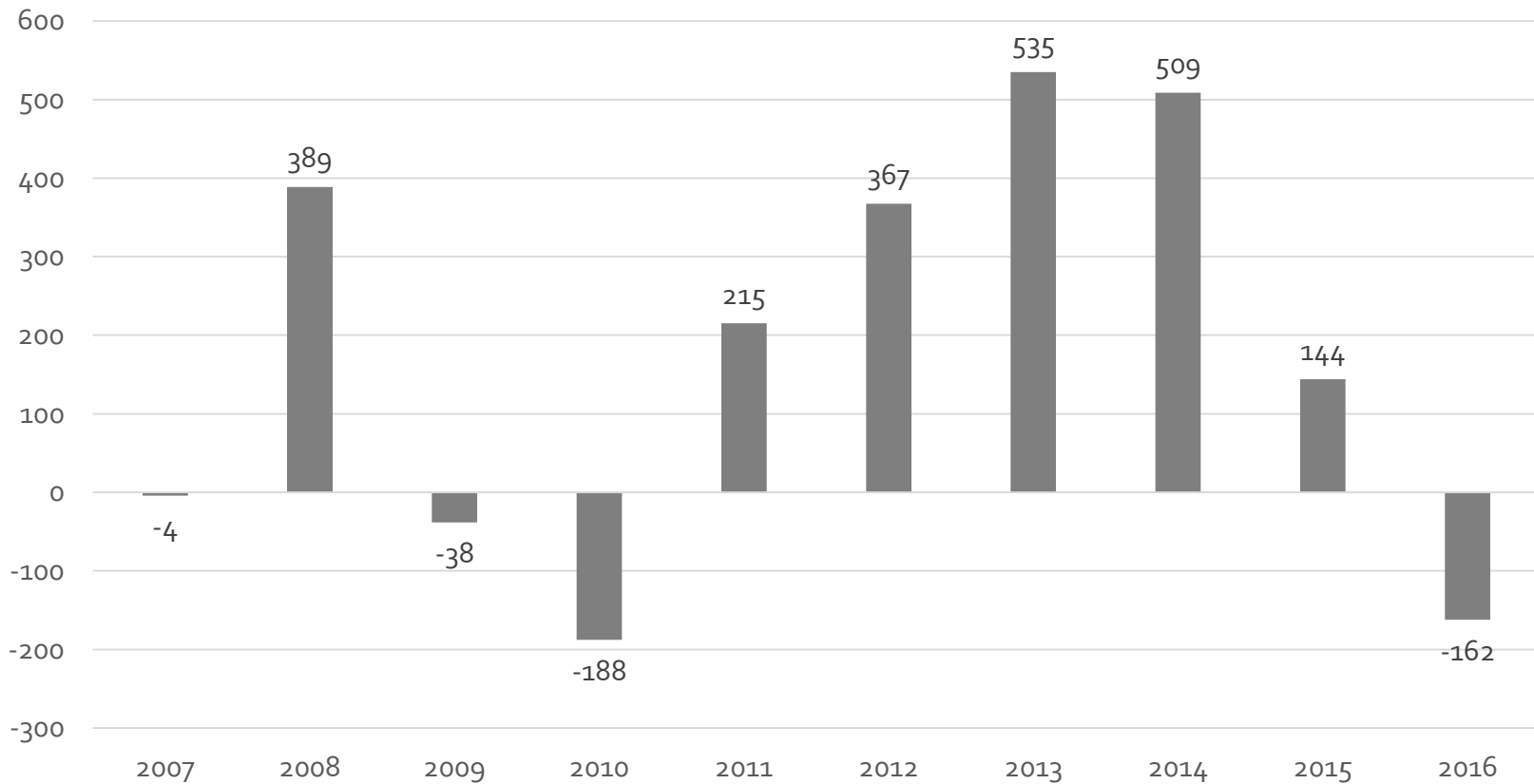

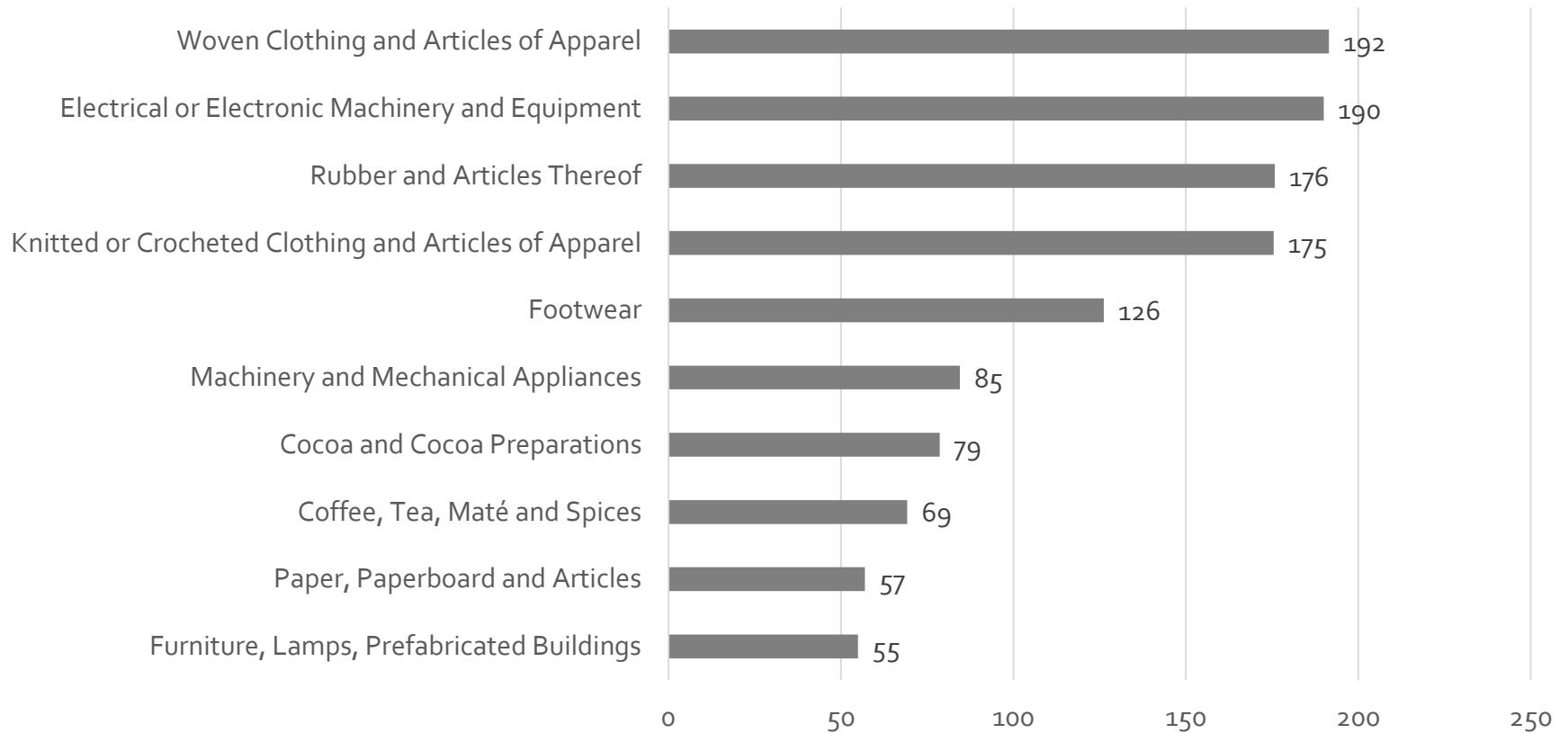

# Canada's Top 10 Merchandise Imports from Indonesia, 2016

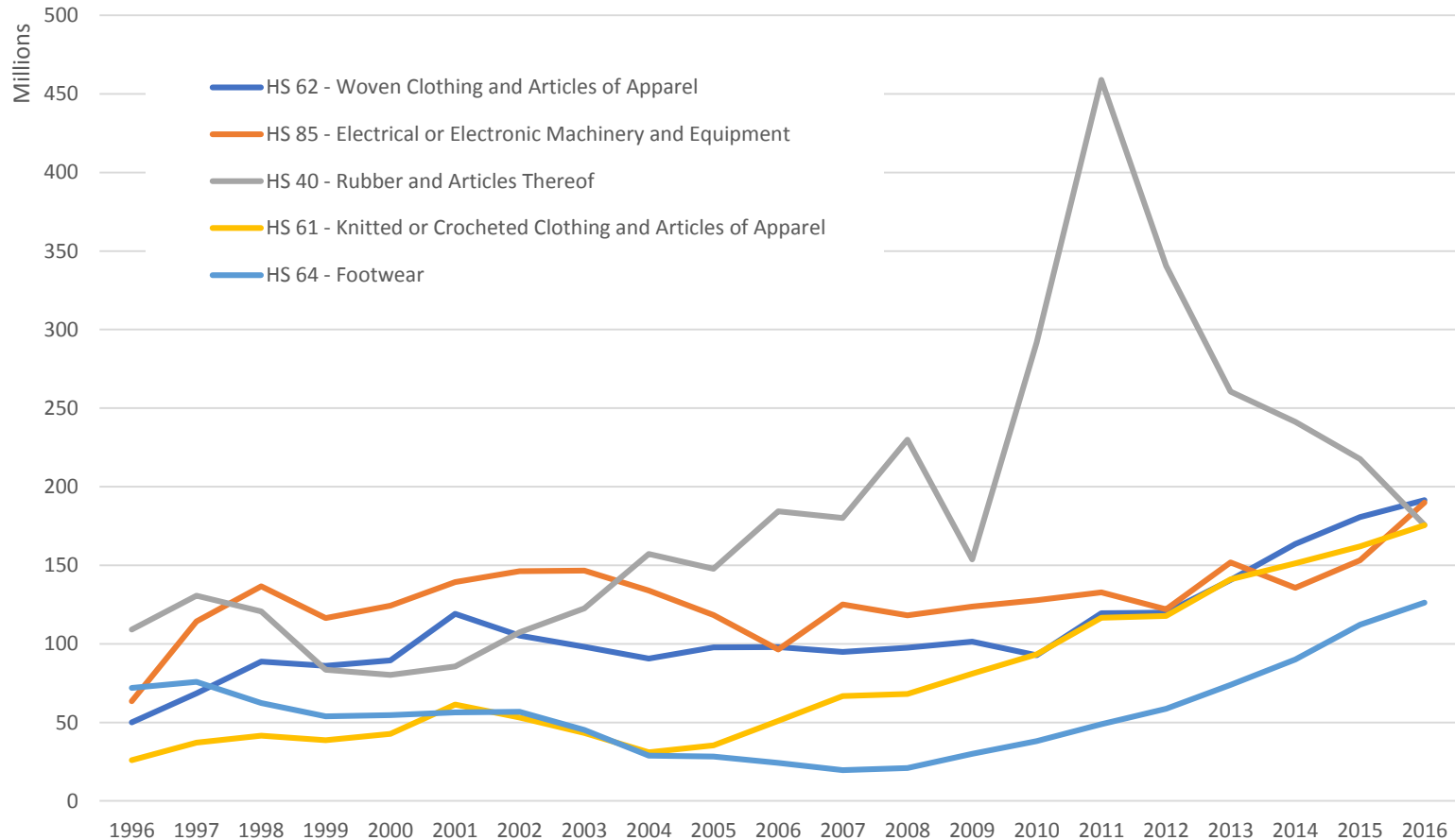

# Indonesia's Top Five Imports to Canada

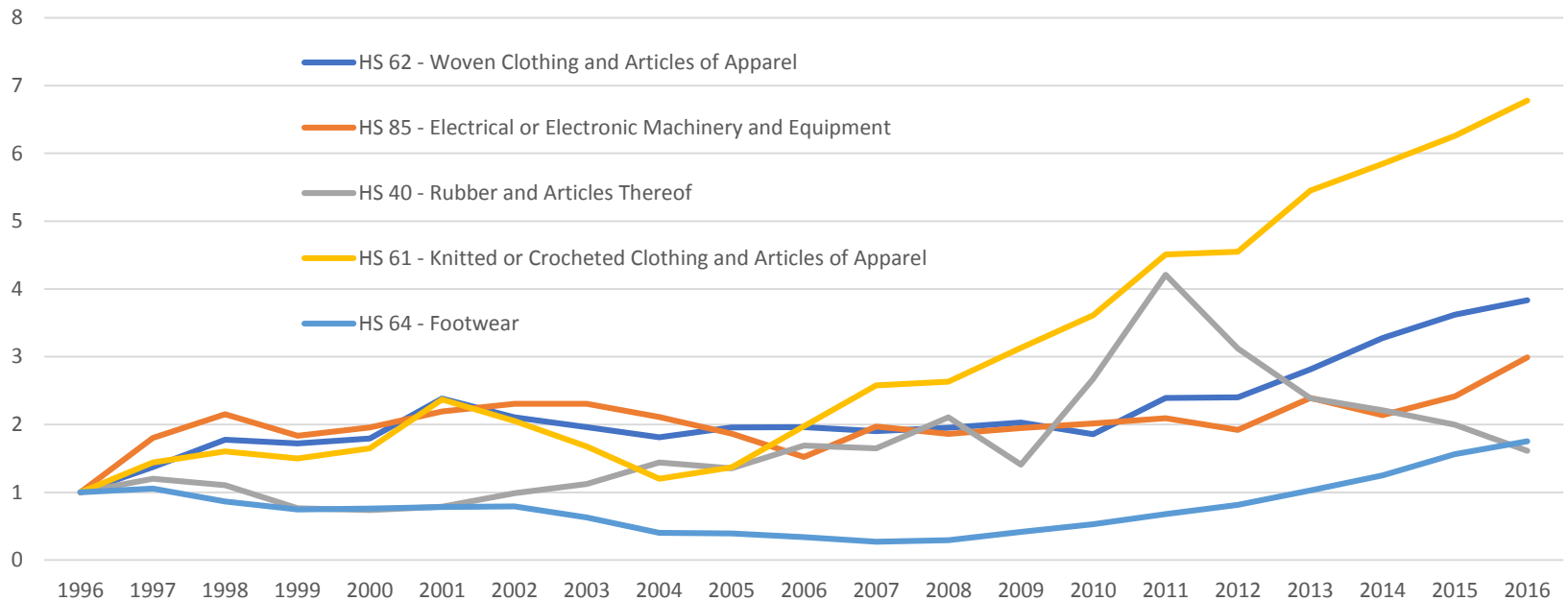

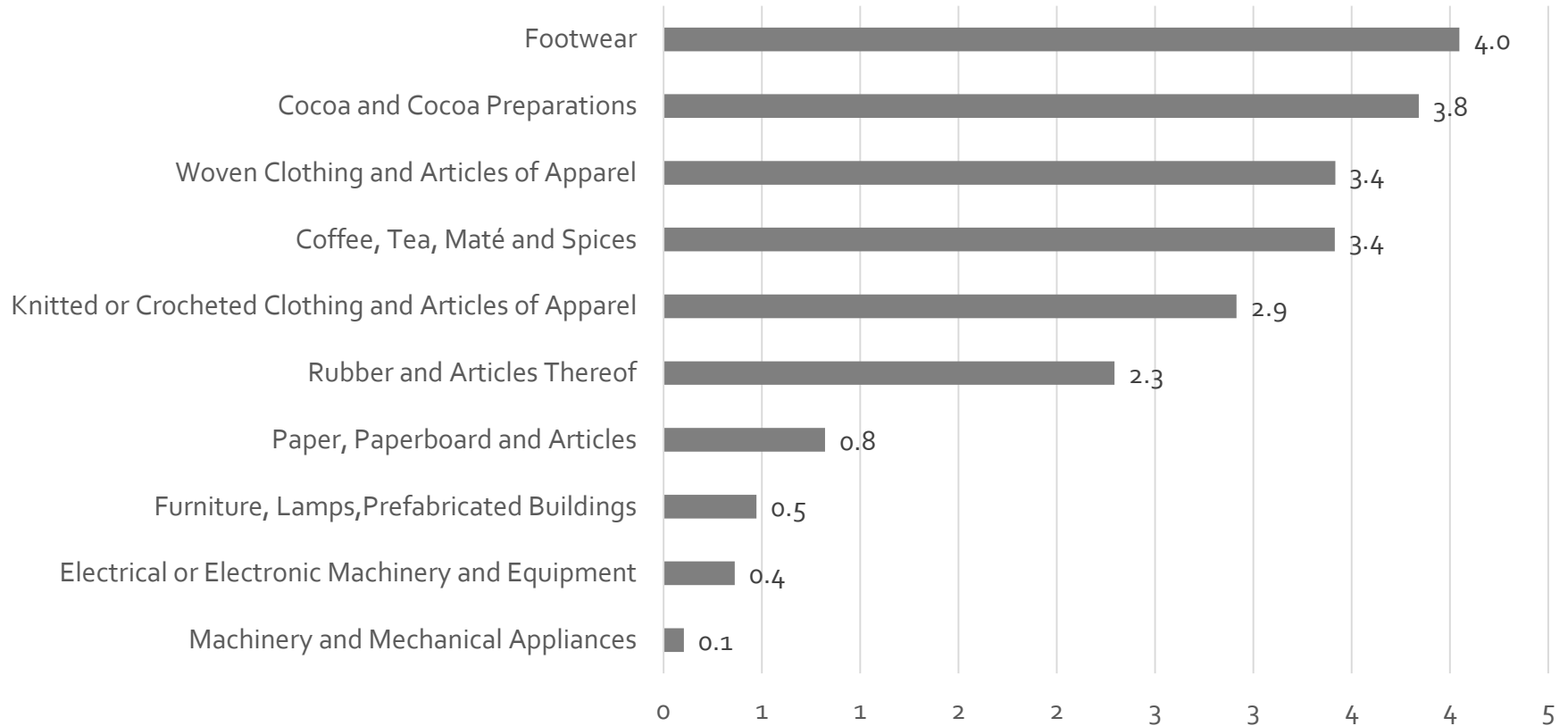

# Indonesia's Market Share of Top 10 Imports from Indonesia, 2016

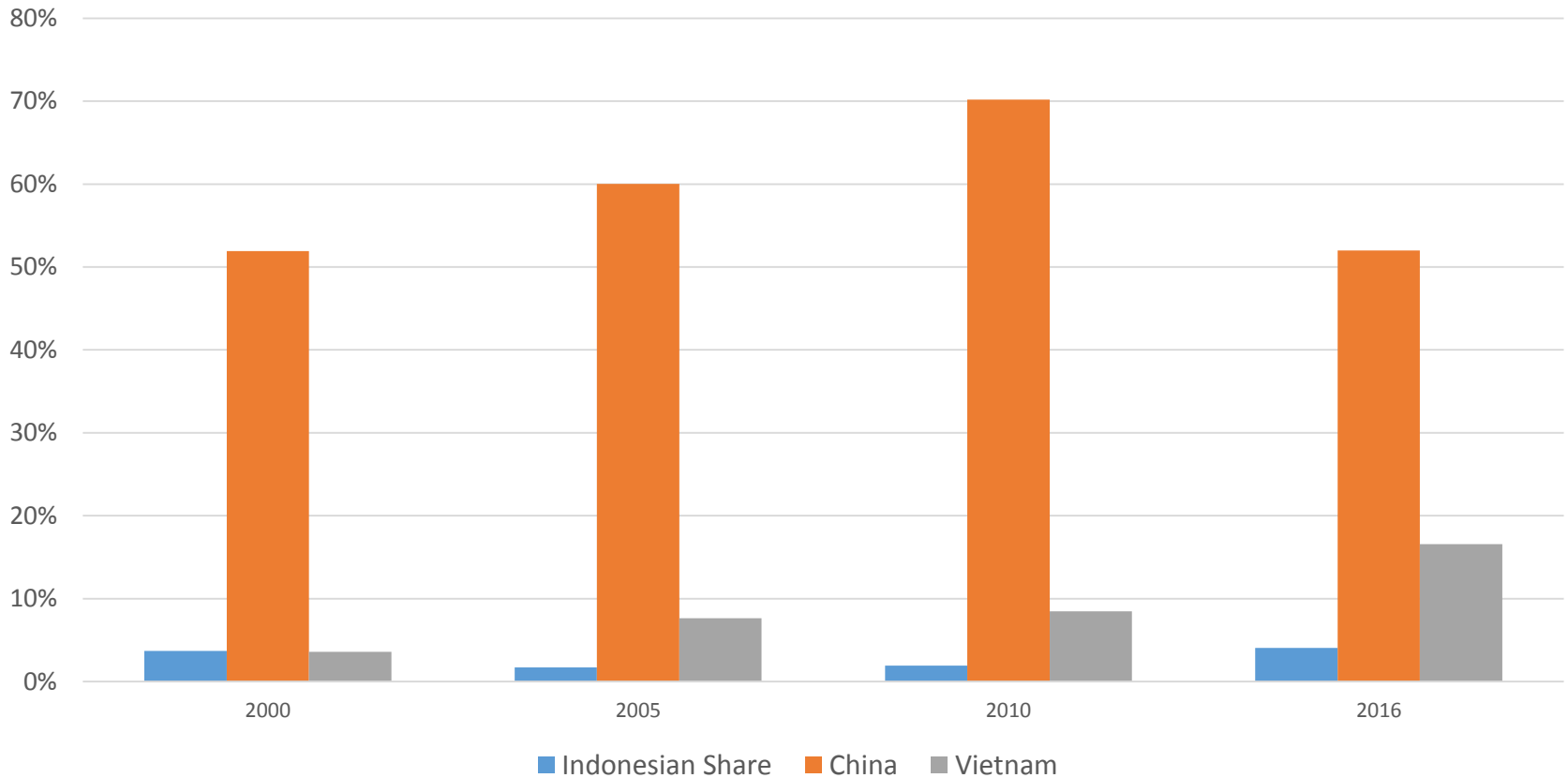

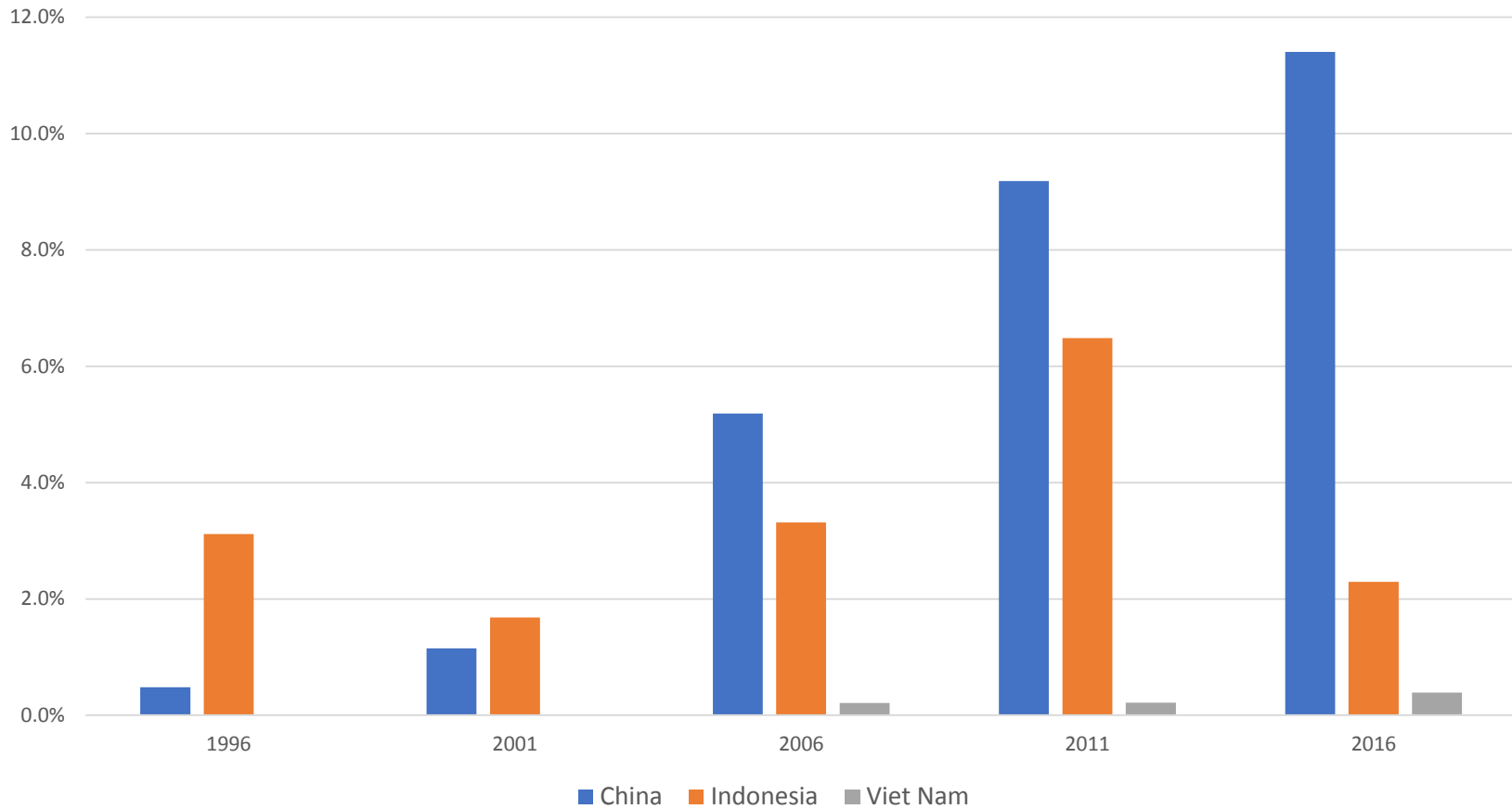


# Market Share for Footwear over time



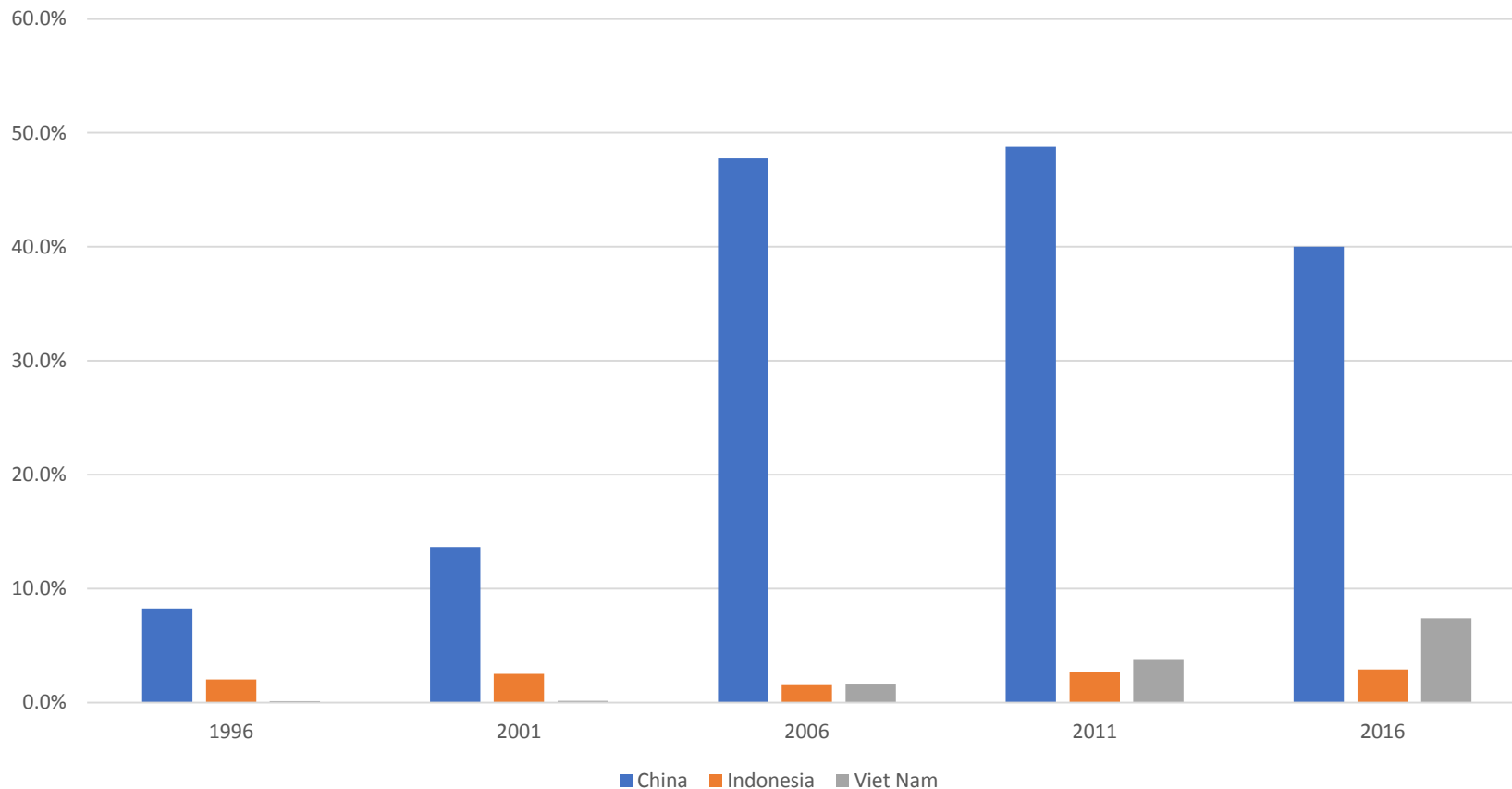

# Market Share for Rubber over time

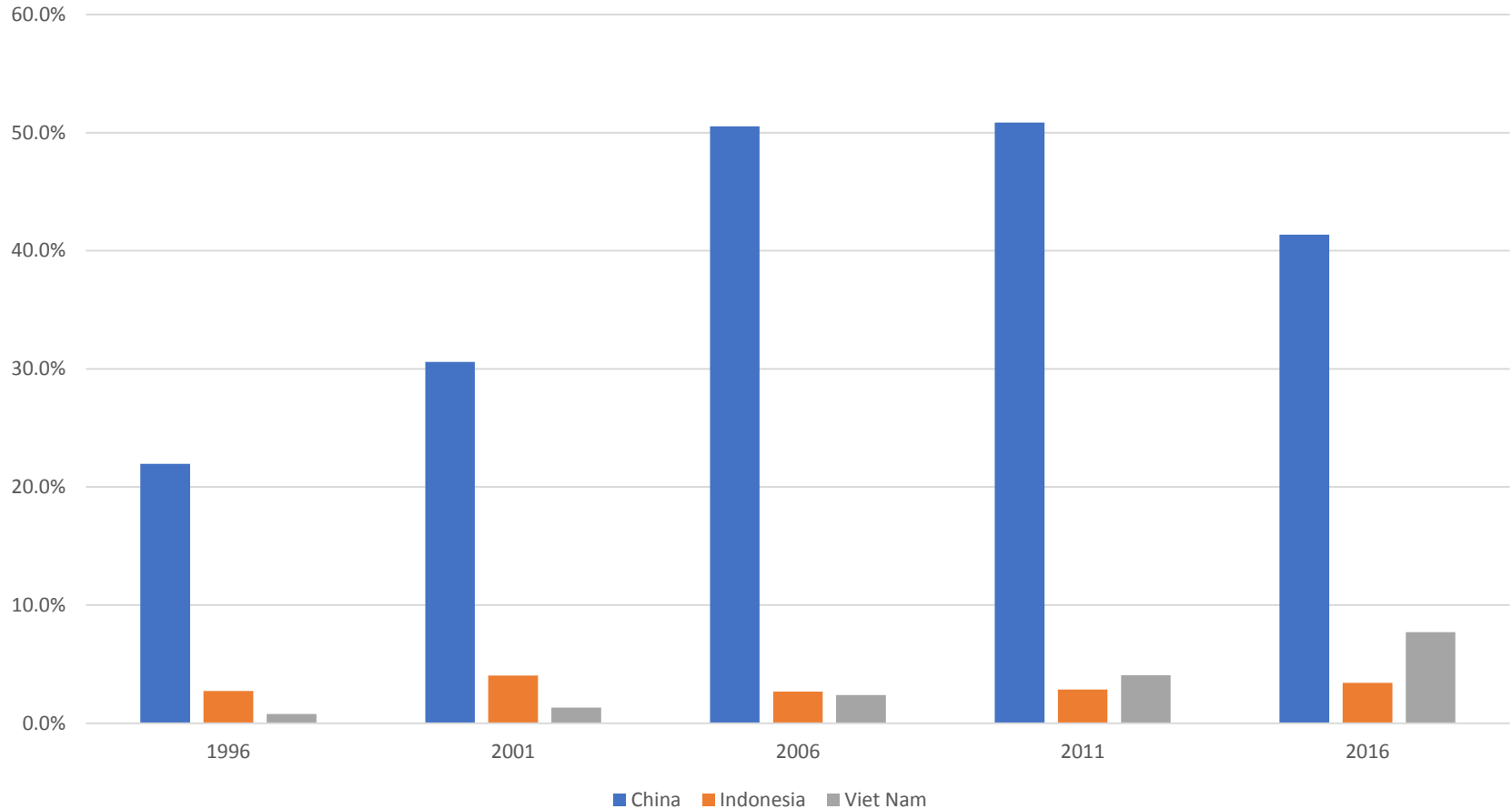

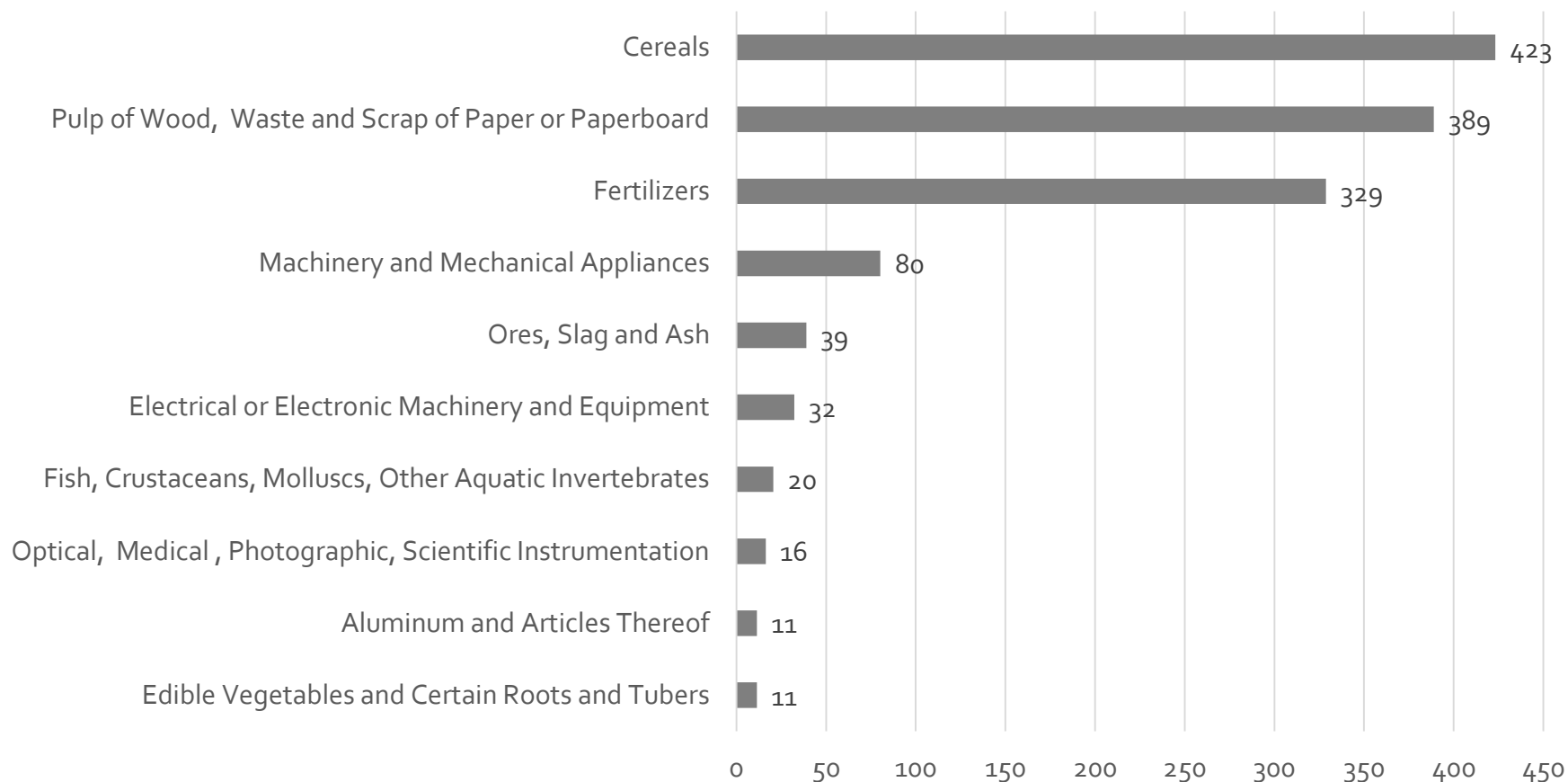
# Indonesia – Canadian Trade is Affected by High Tarriffs

- Indonesia faces an 18 per cent average tariff on apparel.
- This compares to no tariff on the 16 countries we have free trade agreements with.
- Zero for many other countries with the least developed country status
- Footwear has an 18-20 per cent tarrif

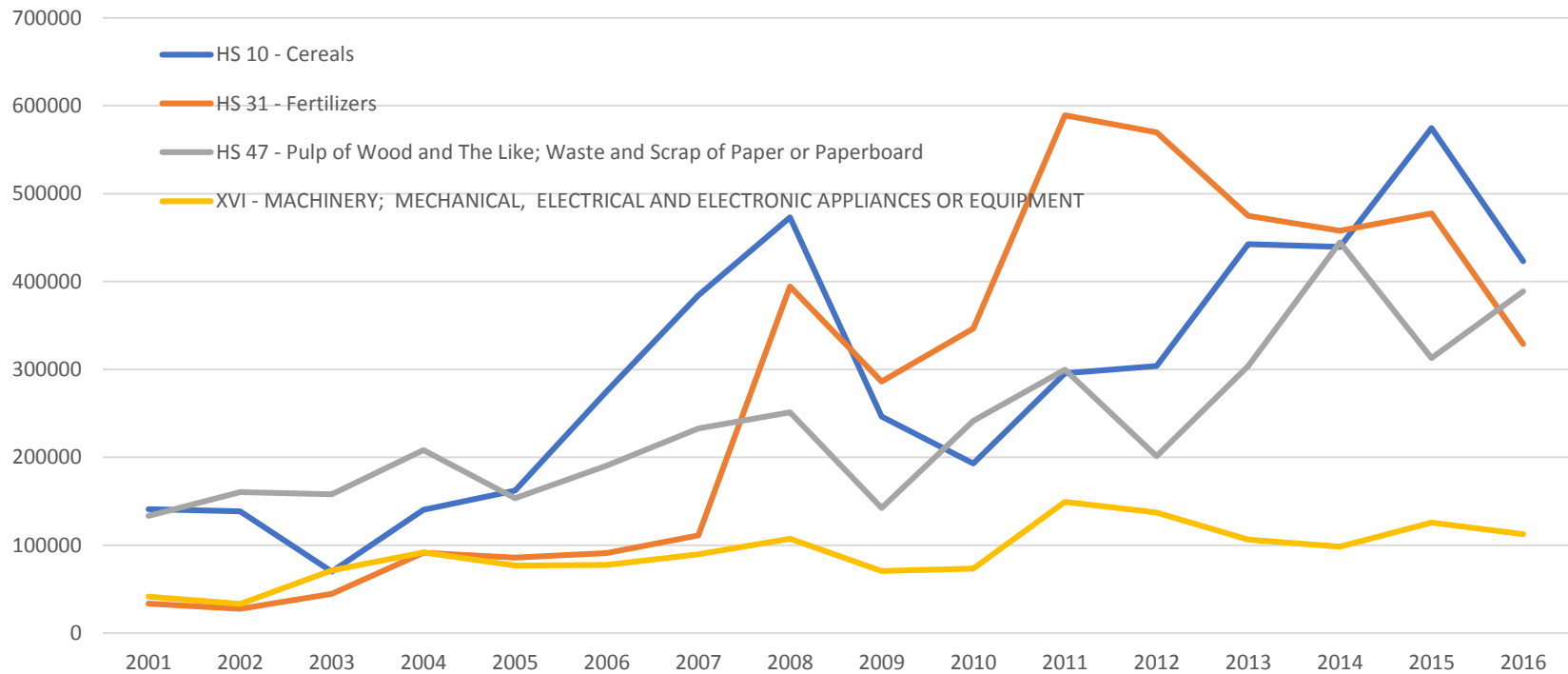

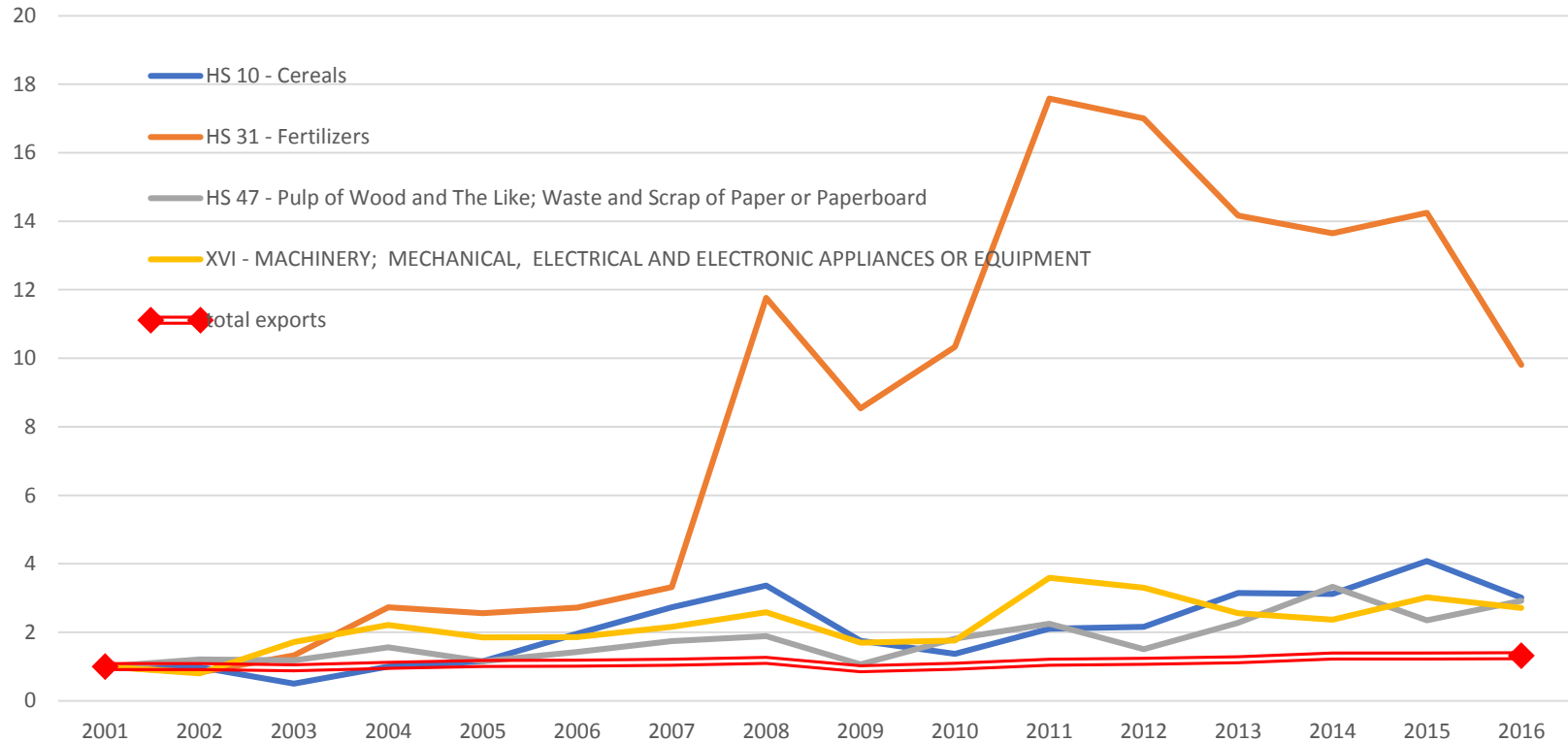
